Official Rules

Purpose: Giving back to those who go above and beyond each day to bring hope to the lives of young people is the reason Play It Forward was created. We are grateful for those who take children into their hearts and homes. Kids just need to be kids and should have the opportunity to experience old fashioned play on a playset that is strong, safe, and fun. Quite simply, we believe in kids and the people who invest in them.

Eligibility Guidelines: The Play It Forward program is open to members of the National Foster Parent Association in good standing who reside in the United States. Application forms must include a reference letter from current Licensing Foster Parent Agency, entry form, and a 250 word essay. Employees of CedarWorks or the National Foster Parent Association, its affiliates and each of their respective employees, shareholders, officers, directors, agents, members, successors and assigns, as well as immediate family (spouse, parent, siblings, and children) and household members of each such employee are not eligible to receive a playset through the Play It Forward program.

Sponsor: The Play It Forward program is sponsored by CedarWorks, 799 Commercial Street, Rockport, Maine in partnership with the National Foster Parent Association.

Giveaway Period: The giveaway begins January 17, 2017 and ends on March 15, 2017. Data forms and essays submitted before or after the giveaway period will be disqualified.

How to Enter: E-mail completed applications to info@nfpaonline.org by March 15, 2017.

By applying for the Play It Forward program, you agree that your submission conforms to and complies with the Official Rules. CedarWorks or the National Foster Parent Association may disqualify you from the program if your submission fails to conform to the requirements and Official Rules.

Essay Contest Guideline: Topic: "How would a CedarWorks playset benefit the children in your care?" in 250 words. We can think of a million ways a playset could benefit any child but we are looking for you to tell us specifically based on your experience with the children in your home.

Selection Guidelines: On or about April 17, 2017, a panel of judges from the National Foster Parent Association will forward 20 applicants to CedarWorks. In its sole discretion, CedarWorks will select up to ten foster parent families from among the eligible submissions.

Notification: Play It Forward playset recipients will be selected twice a year. The first round of winners will be notified on or before May 15, 2017. The second round of recipients will be notified on or before September 15, 2017. All recipients will be required to complete and sign an affidavit of eligibility and publicity release within ten (10) days of the date of notification by CedarWorks. Failure to comply with this requirement for any reason will result in disqualification and participation in the Play It Forward program will be forfeited.

Requirements of Potential Recipients: By participating in the Play It Forward program, recipient grants CedarWorks and the National Foster Parent Association, a royalty-free, irrevocable right to use, print, publish, distribute and display submissions, giveaway information and any photographs within the confines of the confidentiality regulations and laws of the National Foster Parent Association. Recipient acknowledges he/she will not receive payment from the CedarWorks or the National Foster Parent Association for the use of these materials.

What Will You Receive: Home owners are eligible to receive either an Indoor playset or an Outdoor playset. Recipients who do not own their own home are eligible for an Indoor playset only. The playset is not transferrable, and cannot be redeemed for cash. CedarWorks will donate the playset and pay for shipping. The recipient is solely responsible for the landscaping and ground surfacing in preparation for their playset delivery as well as installation, regular maintenance, and upkeep.

Privacy and Publicity: CedarWorks will publish photographs or essay information from the Play It Forward recipient and use their name and likeness in CedarWorks print, online, and video-based marketing materials, as well as other CedarWorks publications within the confines of the confidentiality regulations and law. Recipient's participation is voluntary and they will not receive financial compensation of any type associated with the taking or publication of photographs, essay information or participation in company marketing materials or other CedarWorks publications. CedarWorks, its employees, and any third parties involved in the creation or publication of marketing materials are released from liability for any claims by the recipient or any third party in connection with their participation.
